## NWPA SOCIETY OF PLASTICS ENGINEERS [S12] MEMBERS SCHOLARSHIP RULES AND GUIDELINES

- 1. Eligible applicants are child dependents of current NWPA SPE members, who are in their senior year of high school and planning on attending college.
- 2. This award is a one-time monetary donation, up to \$500, to be used for college costs.
- 3. This award will be paid directly to the college of choice, with proven acceptance.
- 4. Application selection is by a NWPA SPE Board of Directors sub-committee. No Board member with eligible applicants will be allowed to serve on this sub-committee.
- 5. Application criteria include:

Child dependent of a NWPA SPE member in good standing Student gpa of 2.5 or greater and a written essay Student's participation in curricular and extra-curricular activities Sponsoring member's years of SPE membership

- 6. To apply, submit the following items by AUGUST 1, 2019:
  - ✓ Completed and signed award application
  - ✓ Copy of high school transcripts
  - ✓ Supporting essay
  - ✓ Copy of Letter of Acceptance from College
  - ✓ Student resume, if available
